Conditions: Accommodation in Twin/Triple/Four Bed Rooms with shower and toilet inside, TV, Full Board, Ski Course, Social Program, Insurance

Estimated costs for the ski pass: €100,00 – 200,00 (depends on level of skiing); have to be paid on site. Passport picture is required. Please send it by normal mail or by email together with your registration. For reduced price on ski passes we ask you to inform us of the level of disability (in %) and if an accompanying person is always necessary.

Program:

- Skiing and Snowboarding course for beginners, advanced and racers
- Orthopedics - check by a specialist, classification
- Evening activities

Target group:

Beginners, advanced and racers, children, teenager and adults of the CP-Classes C5-C8

Preconditions for participation:

- Walking without help on the bottom and up and downstairs
- Standing on one leg right and left
- Standing up from the ground without help
- Independence in daily affairs (or self paying escort)

Insurance/Liability: The organizer is not responsible for any injuries and damages. Insurance is included in the Participation Fee!

Equipment: Can be rent for a small charge at place.
